

GENOA BRIDGE COLLAPSE IMPACT ON SHIPMENT [AUGUST 2018]

Leghorn, 16th August 2018

Good day,

As everyone well know, on Tuesday 14th August a highway bridge collapsed in Genoa. This heavy tragedy caused a high number of human lost. The situation is still critical and rescue force are always engaged to save eventually missing people.

Surely impact will be interested on moving of unit we are loading from Genoa – but not also.

The fact happened in a focal area for the Italian Northwest regions (Liguria, Piemonte and Lombardia), where all containers are normally moved both via railway and via truck.

Today is too early to know the alternative solution will be placed – while all parties involved are studying for it.

Surely heavy delay and congestion is expected going forward for any shipment originating from those areas. Maybe extra costs to move unit, using alternative roads/ rail tracking way, should be necessary.

From our side we'll inform you as soon as we have any news.
